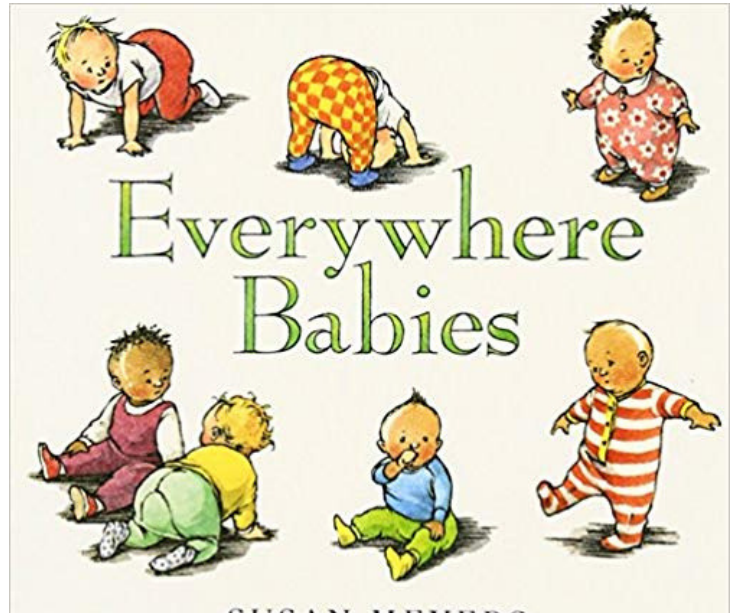

CONVERSATION STARTERS

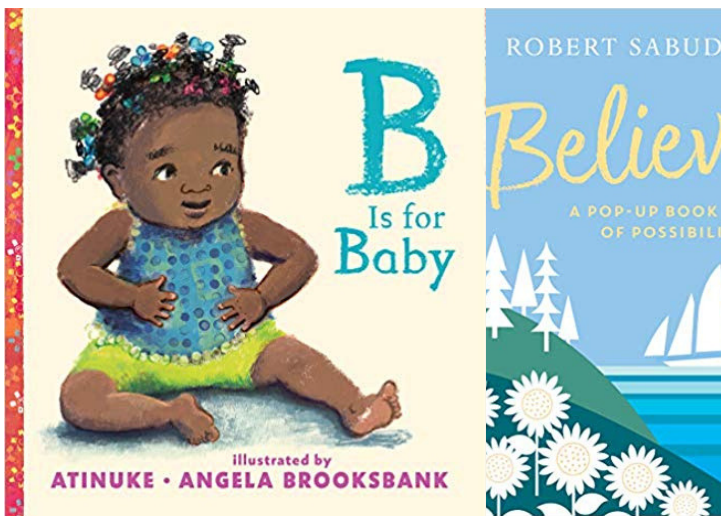
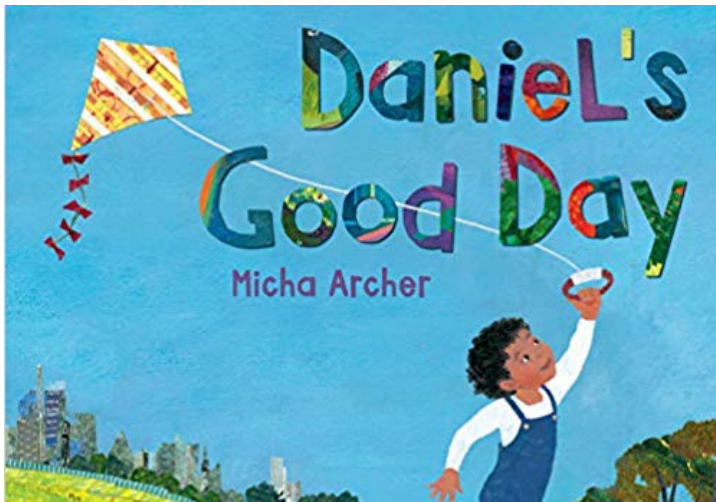
- There are different ways to read this book. You can read the larger font on top or the smaller font on the bottom of the page. You can read the whole book or just talk about pictures.

PLOT SUMMARY

PLAY A SCARF GAME

Families love playing games. A simple item can provide endless hours of entertainment. Try these fun scarf games:

- **Play Peak-a-Boo.** Put the scarf on your face and remove. Say Peak-a-boo. Repeat and giggle.
- **Toss.** Throw the scarves into the air and see where they land. Crawl or run after them.
- **Pretend Play.** Pretend to sneeze: a-a-CHOO! Watch the scarf fly and your toddler giggle.
- **Hide & Seek.** Play hide the scarf with the whole family.
- **Build Rhythm.** Throw on some music & wave the scarves to the beat. Go high, low, fast and slow.
- **Sort.** Organize scarves by color, size and/or shape.
