READING TIPS

- Remember to hold the book close if the babies are newborns.



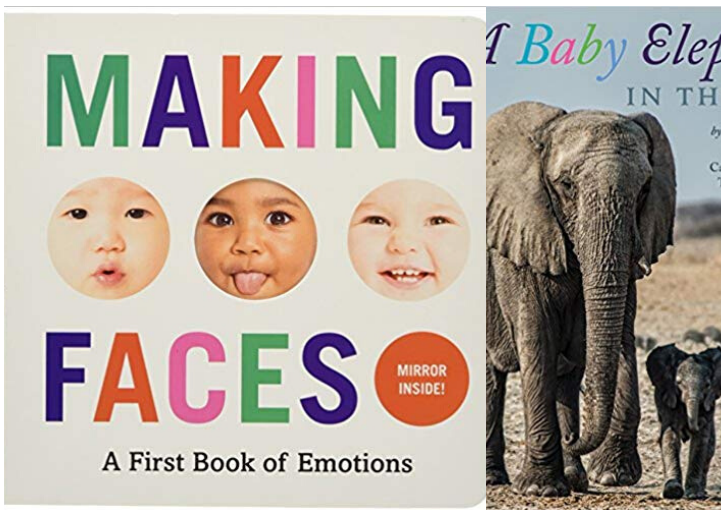
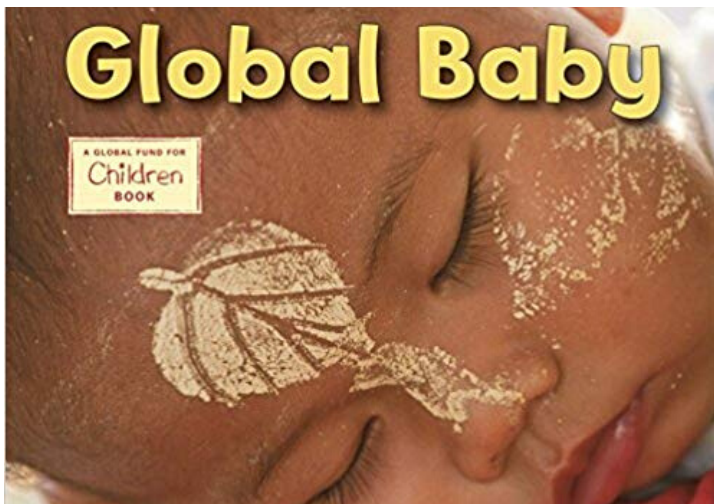
PLOT SUMMARY
