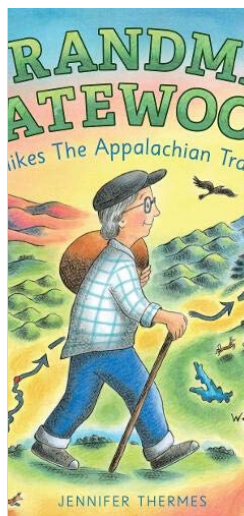
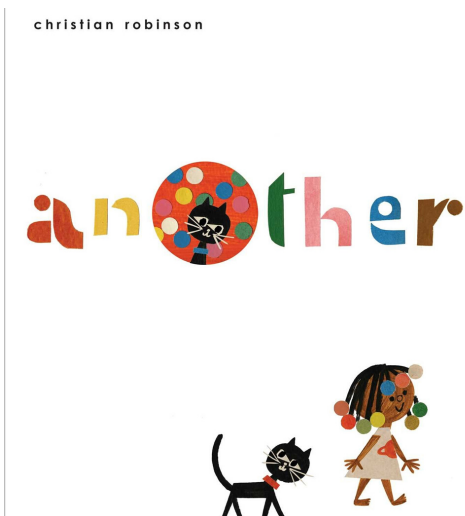
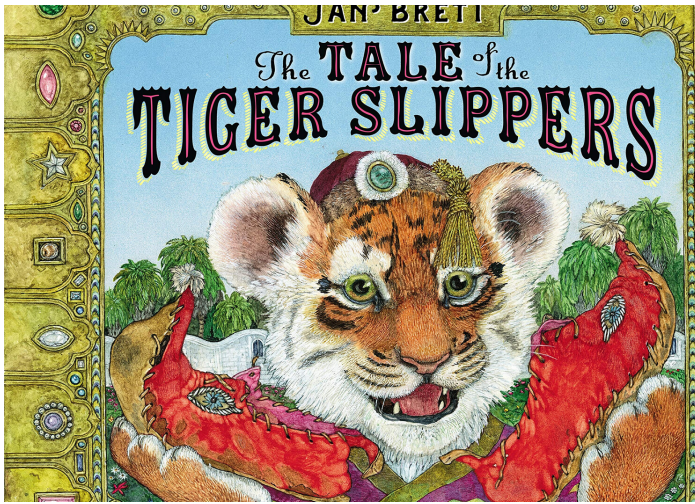


PLOT SUMMARY
