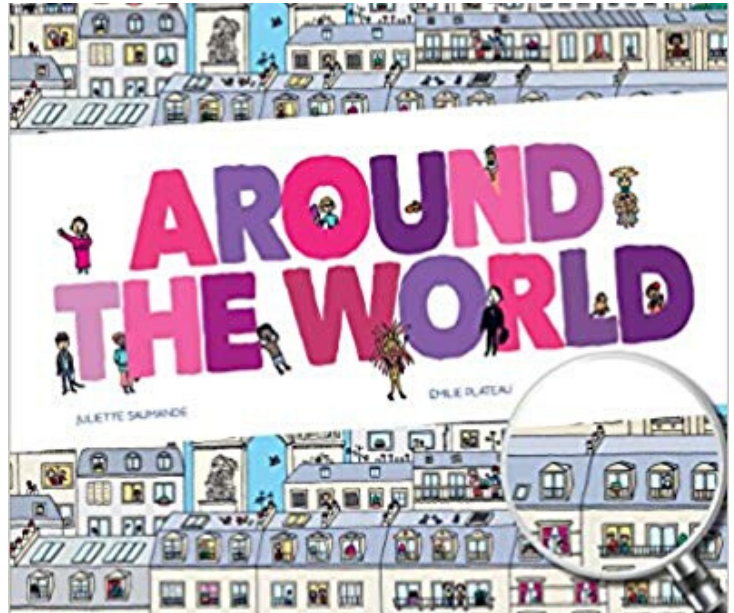

- Help build your child's identity as a reader by celebrating his/her victory in searching and finding objects.

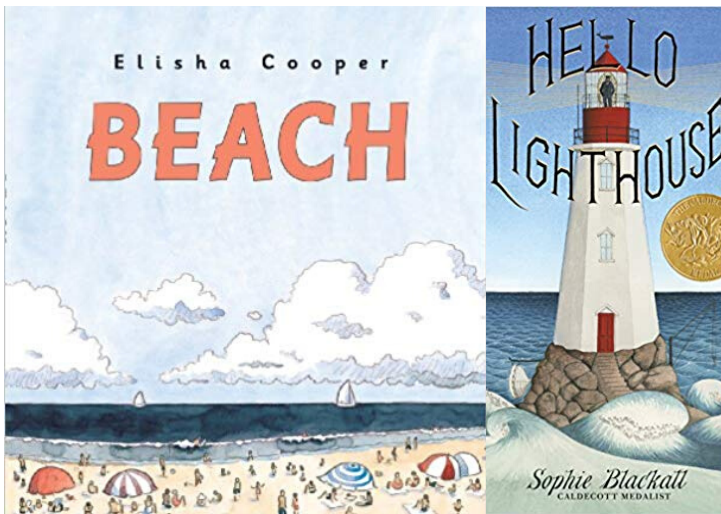


PLOT SUMMARY
