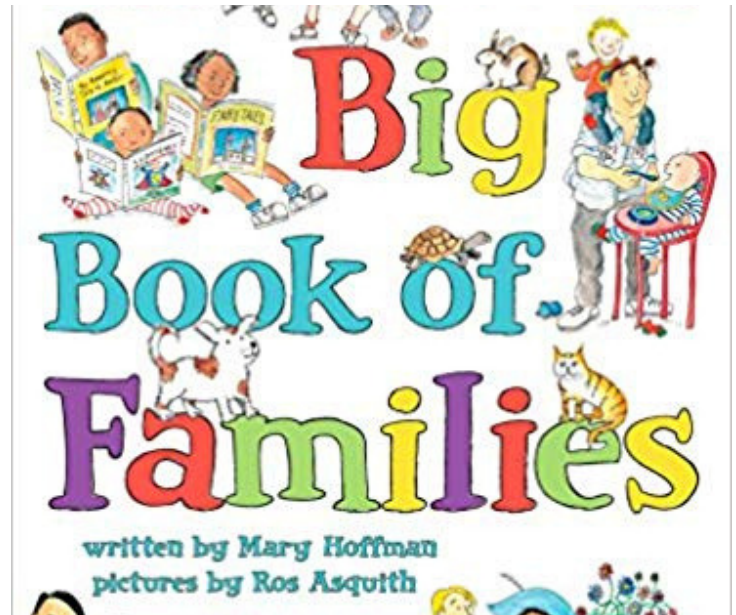

- What holidays does your family celebrate?

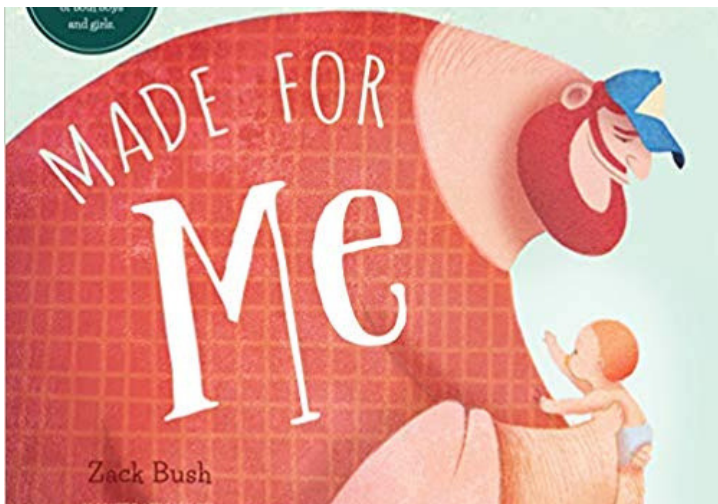


PLOT SUMMARY
